

DPF – Diesel Particulate Filter Maintenance & Treatments -- ECOFuelMax

The Soot and Particulates are un-burnt fuel. Diesel motors that stop and go like School Buses, Transit Buses and Waste Vehicles experience a greater occurrence of cogged filters.

All Diesel motors since 2007 will experience the need for DPF maintenance. Many ask is there a way to totally eliminate DPF maintenance? The answer is legally No; but there are treatments like additives and fuel filters that can help.

There are over 20 fuel additives that all claim to work. The negatives are that they require adding it regularly to the fuel. The other negative is the continued cost, on average +/-\$10.00 per fill up.

When a DPF gets clogged you have a few options to clean your filter. The first plan available is having a company heat it and remove the Carbon. The cost \$350 to \$600 plus labor. Cleaning a DPF at 1800 degrees can crack the ceramic median and the filter needs to be replaced. A new DPF costs +/-\$3000.

In the last few years by accident a Transportation Manager who had some Cobra Clean to remove the faded yellow paint from his School Buses took some home to clean his BBQ grill.
